**Year 5 Curriculum Overview – Trinity Term 2018**

<b>English</b>	Goodnight Mr Tom by Michelle Magorian Grammar: relative clauses, forms of parenthesis, apostrophes, spelling, proofreading and editing. Descriptive writing from a picture. Creative writing and planning techniques. Letter, leaflet writing and diary entries. 11+ type comprehensions
<b>Maths</b>	Revision of all topics, Fractions, algebra, area and volume, equations, negative numbers, co-ordinates, graphs, angles, handling data, percentages, averages, transformations, calculator skills, multiplying and division, methods.
<b>Science</b>	Adaptations and habitats Chemical changes Forces
<b>Geography</b>	Map skills. Revision of all topics. Compass directions. Scales. Ordnance Survey maps.
<b>History</b>	The failure of Versailles; German re-armament and Appeasement; The road to World War Two ; the evacuation from Dunkirk; The Blitz; The Home Front; D-Day Landings.
<b>Music</b>	Investigating compound time; time signatures using minims; further recognition of notes; syncopation; learning to phrase. Preparation for end of term concert.
<b>Religious Education</b>	Study of Judaism: Looking at Jewish festivals, beliefs and teachings, and lifestyle. Study of Sikhism: Looking at Sikh festivals, beliefs and teachings, and lifestyle.
<b>Computing</b>	Typing and E Safety & Internet reliability
<b>PSHCE</b>	Pupil Council SEAL link: caring for others CITIZENSHIP: Human rights / Judging by appearances ECONOMIC: Rich World, Poor World
<b>French</b>	Tricolore Total 1: Places in Town At the Tourist Office Directions A typical day Time Likes and dislikes of school subjects School Life in France School timetable
<b>DT</b>	Students will build on their experience of soldering from last year. They will complete the circuit in a moisture-reader kit, and learn about more complicated components. They will also construct a frame that will be vacuum formed, to make a tray they can use to plant seeds.
<b>Art</b>	Drawing with oil pastels. Food theme. Painting. Lino printing. Mixed media. Group artwork.
<b>PE</b>	Athletics: pupils taught the correct technique for each event and assessed in line with the STG award scheme. Track events: sprints, hurdles, distance, relays. Field events: high jump, long jump, ball throw.
<b>Boys' Games</b>	CRICKET: Team selection (Colts A,B,C & Development). Fielding skills. Bowling technique. Batting. Fielding positions. Running between wickets / communication. Hard ball for A, B and later, C. Incred-ball Development teams - timed / limited over game. Tennis and softball will also be played on occasions.
<b>Girls' Games</b>	ROUNDERS: Throwing - underarm, overarm, distance. Catching - moving to the side. Bowling – with accuracy and speed. Fielding - responding to oppositional play. Hitting - striking for accuracy. Developing an understanding of match play and rules. CRICKET: introduction to the basic cricket skills of batting/bowling/fielding and match play
