Year 6 Curriculum Overview – Trinity Term 2018

English	Writing Skills: focus on continued comprehension practice and use of 11+ CE papers. Poetry and speech writing for debate. Exam revision – 11+ Grammar and Punctuation: continued work on parts of speech, suffixes, proofreading Spelling: continued spelling practice and tests Class Reader: 'Holes' by Louis Sachar
Maths	Calculations including order of operations, fractions, decimals and percentages, angles of regular polygons including interior and exterior angles, bearings, revision for exams, probability including venn diagrams.
Science	Electricity & electrical circuits The Skeletal system. Separating mixtures: using techniques such as filtration, distillation & chromatography.
Geography	Africa. Food and Farming in Kenya – inc subsistence farming. Sustainable Development. Extended essay-writing skills. Tourism in the UK.
History	Medieval England - How medieval people lived, Henry II and Thomas Becket, King John and the Magna Carta and The Black Death.
Music	Recognising instruments; key signatures; continued recognition of notes; <i>Aurelia</i> and <i>Musition</i> software. Preparation for <i>Pandemonium</i> .
Religious Education	Major Christian festivals and seasons including Holy Week and Easter, Ascension and Pentecost. The growth of the Early Church. Christian initiation services: Baptism and Confirmation
Computing	Typing and Espresso Coding Unit 6B
PSHCE	Pupil Council Drugs Education – Alcohol abuse SEAL links: Keeping myself Safe CITIZENSHIP: GB - A Multi-Cultural Society, stereotyping
French	6XG: Expo 2 Vert: leisure with friends, TV programmes, last weekend, invite someone to go out & making excuses, describe clothes 6XS, 6XT: Expo 2 Rouge: as 6X2 plus opinion about TV programmes, TV habits, describe own and other people's last weekend, what you are going to wear
Spanish	Mira 1 – Unit 2 (3): brothers and sisters, likes and dislikes of school subjects, snacks Grammar: conjugation (sing.) of "tener" and "gustar", adjectival endings, possessive adjectives mi(s), tu(s) and su(s)
Latin	2 nd Conjugation in two tenses. Infinitives. 2 nd declension neuter and masculine. Translation from and into Latin, revising all vocabulary and endings taught thus far. Numbers & Numerals. Roman Legends including Aeneas, Romulus and Remus, and the Etruscans.
DT	Design and make a phone stand, and make a speaker, including soldering the circuit and vacuum forming the case. Each child will continue with their Design Technology portfolio.
Art	Printing and painting. Artist study – Optical art.
PE	Athletics: pupils taught the correct technique for each event and assessed in line with the STG award scheme. Track events: sprints, hurdles, distance, relays. Field events: high jump, long jump, shot putt.

Boys' Games	CRICKET: Team selection (Colts A,B,C & Development). Fielding skills. Bowling technique. Batting. Fielding positions. Running between wickets / communication. Hard ball for A, B and C's later in term. Incredi-ball for Developments - timed / limited over game. Tennis and softball will also be played on occasions.
Girls' Games	ROUNDERS: Throwing - fielding in from the deep positions. Catching - one-handed and backstop skills. Bowling and fielding speed and accuracy. Hitting - correct foot placement and rules of the square. Attempting to hit for direction and distance. Developing reaction time as batter - hit and run - awareness of positions of others. CRICKET: introduction to the basic cricket skills of batting/bowling/fielding and match play
Food Technology	Introduction to safe food handling and learning to follow a recipe step-by-step.
